

BUILDING PERMIT INFORMATION

The Town Board of the Town of Seneca on April 8, 2008 adopted Ordinance 2008-01, Town Building Information Permit Ordinance.

The purpose of this ordinance is for the Town to have information regarding the type, size and location of all buildings and structures constructed, reconstructed, remodeled, removed, or demolished in the Town of Seneca.

A Town Building Permit should be obtained **prior** to commencing any construction, installation, remodeling, reconstruction, enlargement, altering, removing or demolishing any building. A town permit is **not** required when the cost of work, including labor, is less than \$2,000

The cost of the permit is \$15.00. This permit is in addition to any State or County permits, and any inspection fees.

- Please be advised that property on or near water may fall under Green Lake County's Shoreland Zoning Ordinance. Please check with the County's Land Use Planning and Zoning Department before proceeding. 920-294-4156.
- Sanitary permits for work involving private sewage systems must also be obtained from the county.
- Most building projects involving commercial buildings, 1-2 family dwellings, or any project that includes electrical wiring require a building inspection. Inspection services are provided by *Grand Valley Inspection Services* - 920-229-6360. It is YOUR responsibility to contact them **prior** to beginning any work.

Obtaining all necessary permits and/or inspections, and paying the required fees for said services are **your** responsibility. The Town of Seneca does **not** do this for you.
