

OPERATOR'S LICENSE ORDINANCE

Ordinance No. 25-01

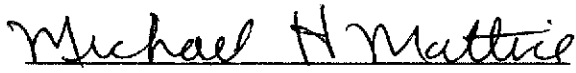
1. **AUTHORIZATION:** Pursuant to s. 125.17,(1) Wis.Stats, the Town of Seneca, Green Lake County, desires to establish standards under which Operator's licenses may be issued.
2. **ELIGIBILITY:** A person may apply for an Operator's license provided that the applicant is 18 years of age or older, does not have an arrest or conviction record, is not a habitual law offender and has successfully completed a DAB approved responsible beverage server training course required under s.125.04(5), Wis.Stats.
3. **VALIDITY:** Operator's Licenses are only valid within the Town of Seneca, Green Lake County. s.125.17(2) Wis.Stats
4. **APPLICATION:** Application for an Operators' License shall be made to the Town Clerk or Town Treasurer on such form designated by the Clerk and shall be accompanied by the fee set forth in paragraph 7 below.
5. **STANDARD:** No Operator's license shall be granted if the applicant has been denied by the Town Board.
6. **TERM:** An Operator's License shall be valid for 2 years commencing from July 1 and shall expire June 30, biennially
7. **FEE:** The fee for an Operator's License will be \$25 for a 2-year term.
8. **REVOCACTION:**
 - a. The Town Clerk shall immediately revoke the operator's license if holder fails to successfully complete the responsible beverage server course required in s. 125.04(5), Wis Stat.
 - b. The Town Clerk shall immediately revoke the operator's license if it is discovered that the holder of the license made a false statement on the application for the Operator's license.

- c. The Town Clerk shall revoke the operator's license if the Town Board denies the applicant's application for an Operator's license.
- d. No part of the fee paid for Operator's license revoked may be refunded.

Revocation of the operator's license shall become effective upon mailing of the notice of revocation by the Town Clerk. Any notice mailed in this ordinance is sufficient if mailed via first class mail to the last known address of the licensee, in an envelope containing the return address of the Town Clerk.
